What is Social Prescribing? Sometimes, as well as or instead of medicine, what someone really needs might be practical help, a friend, physical exercise or good advice. Social prescribing means that this person can be referred to local organisations that provide these things. So, for example, instead of a prescription for medication they might get a 'prescription' to attend a gardening club or help from Citizen's Advice.
